• <b>Q:</b> Did these incidents prompt more patrol?	
• A: DPD is short staffed. When able, increase the driving by, however, being short staffed, the DPD is usually	
responding to 911 calls.	
• <b>Q:</b> What can we do?	
• <b>A:</b> Call City Councilor to say that we are concerned- we	
need more patrols.	
<ul> <li>Maybe a petition? Number, email?</li> <li>Q: Some have gotten calls about doing a neighborhood</li> </ul>	
watch. How does that work now?	
• A: Those are not sponsored by DPD and they don't do	
"training". But Officer Jim is more than willing to sit down and talk with people on what to look for, what to	
do when you see something, and areas to watch that	
are higher crime areas.	
<ul> <li>However, this can be as simple as driving your car</li> </ul>	
around areas that you might not usually drive in. If you see something suspicious, call 911- give good	
description of what they look like, what they are	
wearing, where they are coming from, where they are	
going, exact vehicles they were trying to get into or windows they were looking in.	
<ul> <li>NEVER stop that person or try to stop them which will</li> </ul>	
put yourself in harm. Call 911 if we see something	
suspicious.	
<ul> <li>New public information officer         <ul> <li>Has been doing great with posting on FB when</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
something big is happening.	
Officer Jim has been monitoring many of the community

<ul> <li>We are on the bottom of pay in the state for police officers. City officials are working on hopefully</li> </ul>	
increasing pay to entice officers here, as well as keep	
and maintain officers.
